

ENTRY: Registration available online ONLY! Participants **MUST** present proof of current USA Wrestling Membership Card (actual card or photo copy) at the event registration. Late, mailed in or on-site entries will not be accepted.

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Online registration will be available at <u>www.themat.com</u> until 12:00 PM (MST) Monday, June 30th. Entry fee is \$35 per style or \$60 for both styles. You MUST pay by credit card when registering online.

All participants MUST turn in the **OFFICIAL WAIVER & REG-ISTRATION FORMS** (Pages 1 and 2, with all necessary signatures—which is available for download at <u>www.themat.com</u>), and a copy of your current USA Wrestling membership card prior to receiving a weigh-in card(s) during event registration.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Attractive awards to the top eight (8) place winners in each style, in each weight class of all divisions. All first place winners will be asked to stay after the awards ceremony for age-group champion photos. **No awards will be given out prior to the awards ceremony**.

RULES: The current rules of FILA, with USA Wrestling modifications where applicable, will govern the event and the competition.

UNIFORMS: Red and blue singlets, or red/blue reversible singlet with underbriefs REQUIRED. For female wrestlers, a collegiate or girls singlet is required and a sleeveless sport top is to be worn under the singlet (no T-shirts). **Headgear is REQUIRED for all competitors. No Two-Piece uniforms are ALLOWED!**

PAIRINGS: Contestants are randomly drawn by computers. Separation of wrestlers per Kids National Championships policy. Two pools will be employed if there are six (6) or more entrants in any given weight class.

COACHING: FLOOR PASS REQUIRED. Coaches floor passes will only be sold (**\$5.00**) to those individuals with a current USAW Coaches Membership Card and who are a minimum USAW NCEP Copper certified. Coaches Membership Cards should be obtained from your state office. Two certified coaches maximum allowed in each competitor's corner. To videotape any match at matside, the operator must be one of the two certified coaches in the corner. Only coaches with a current USAW Coaches Membership Card AND who are USAW NCEP certified are entitled to free admission.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: Athletes must be present in a COMPETITION SINGLET and must submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-ins. The chief medical officer has full authority without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Chief Medical Officer, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

WEIGH-INS: An athlete competing in two styles may weigh in once for both styles. This is contingent on the athlete actively competing in the first of the two wrestling styles scheduled. Athletes competing in one style must weigh-in at the official weigh-in

for that style. All athletes must be present at BEGINNING of weigh-ins. Each athlete will be allowed two consecutive attempts to make weight and may not leave the weigh-in area. All wrestler's must be dressed in a COMPETITION SINGLET for weigh-ins and no weight allowance is given for the singlet. A wrestler may compete in the National Championships at a weight equal to or higher than the lowest weight class, regardless of style, in which he/she qualified at the regional level.

ELIGIBILITY: A wrestler, to be eligible to participate in the 2008 USA Wrestling Kids Freestyle & Greco-Roman National Championships, **MUST HAVE PARTICIPATED IN AT LEAST ONE STYLE** at their designated 2008 USA Wrestling Kids Regional Tournament—**NO EXCEPTIONS**. A wrestler may compete in both styles at the national championships even though he/she only competed in one style at the regional tournament.

The girls divisions/festivals, held at some of the regional championships, are not defined as Regional Championships and thus **DO NOT** fulfill the requirements necessary to compete in the Kids Freestyle & Greco-Roman National Championships.

KIDS TRIPLE CROWN: The Kids Freestyle & Greco-Roman National Championships is the final event in USA Wrestling's prestigious Kids Triple Crown Wrestling Series. Athletes that win the championship at the 2008 ASICS USAW Folkstyle National Championships and 2008 ASICS USAW Freestyle & Greco-Roman National Championships will be recognized as 2008 Triple Crown Champions. Winners will be presented special awards and will be honored in USA Wrestler, the official publication of USA Wrestling. All Triple Crown winners will be asked to remain after the end of the freestyle awards ceremony for recognition and a special photo session.
