Our new state-of-the-art computerized scoring system—also used by the Walsh-Jesuit Ironman Tournament—makes our tournament run smoothly.

A laptop on each mat—set-up on a wireless network—makes scoring easy and tournament results instantaneous. Our seating program is easy enough for any coach to use, and makes seating quick and accurate.

Contestants will see what mat they compete on 4 matches before they wrestle—getting rid of that annoying announcer. In addition, our computer system takes away the need for any stat-girls. Following each round—or at the end of the tournament—a summative printout of each wrestler can be obtained. These printouts break down each match as to who scored what.

Every coach, fan, and wrestler can keep up with matches across the stadium, team scores, and placement, with monitors set up throughout the entire facility.



In addition to the varsity tournament, we simultaneously run a JV Dual Meet Tournament in the same facility—last year each JV team wrestled 5+ duals.

The facility where the tournament is hosted, Vernal Utah’s Western Park Arena, has space for eight mats and seats 4,000 people—all with an excellent view of the mats. In the past, coaches have expressed that this is one of the best-organized and well-run tournaments which they have attended; and now, with our new state-of-the-art computerized scoring system, the tournament runs twice as fast with no down time.
